### **What is TABS?**

TABS stands for the Teen Advisory Board of Swampscott. It is a group of teen volunteers that works to improve the Young Adult department of the library.

### **What will we do?**

We will do a variety of things throughout the year, all with the goal of developing the Teen area. Some of these projects may include: planning programs and displays, testing crafts, evaluating and making suggestions for the collection, working on advertising, etc.

### **How do I become a TABS member?**

### **How often will we meet?**

The TABS group will meet for one hour, once a month.

### **How does this translate to volunteer credit?**

Every meeting you attend will count for two hours of volunteer time (that is one hour for the meeting, and one hour for any work I have you do outside of meetings).

### **What if I miss a meeting?**

Things happen, life gets busy, I understand if you need to miss a meeting. Just let me know ahead of time if you will be absent. Try not to miss more than three months in a row, or more than five months total. If you miss too many, your spot may be given to another volunteer.
